 - iii. Maximizing automation of award procedures
 - iv. Periodic accounting of scholarship awards
 - c. Graduate School
 - i. Student screening data to qualify candidate pool
 - ii. Screening pool for financial hardship
 - iii. Maximizing automation of award procedures
 - iv. Periodic accounting of scholarship awards
