Motion. At our January 28, 2020 meeting, the Faculty Academic Policy and Standards Committee voted unanimously to recommend revisions to the UNC Charlotte Academic Policy concerning the Baccalaureate Degree Progression that are affected by changes in the schedule for summer sessions. A version of the current policy with the tracked recommended changes is appended as a separate document.

Justification.

- The committee agreed that the recommended standard load for students in the summer session was reasonable.
- The committee agreed that changes were necessary to clarify the distinction between the summer session and the fall and spring sessions.

Motion. At our January 28, 2020 meeting, the Faculty Academic Policy and Standards Committee voted unanimously to recommend revisions to the UNC Charlotte Academic Policy concerning Registration that are affected by changes in the schedule for summer sessions with one minor change in the language. A version of the current policy with the tracked recommended changes is appended as a separate document.

Justification.

- Under “DROP/ADD PERIOD,” the committee recommended changing the word “sessions” to “terms” when referring to the first and second five-week summer terms. This language is consistent with that used throughout the policy.
- The committee agreed that the changes are appropriate due to the changes in the summer schedule.
