## STANDING RULES OF THE FACULTY COUNCIL

## ARTICLE V COMMITTEES

Section 5: University Mediation Coordinator/Associate Faculty Ombuds (UMC)

## A. Selection of the UMC

The UMC is a senior Faculty member with permanent tenure who has appropriate knowledge of the University's mediation process. The UMC also serves as

Associate Faculty Ombuds as a substitute for the Faculty Ombuds as needed. The UMC shall be appointed by the Faculty President in accordance with appointment procedures approved by the Faculty. The UMC shall serve a three year term, which is renewable, for a maximum of six consecutive years. The UMC shall not serve on any departmental or college reappointment, promotion, or tenure committee where a conflict of interest exists, or on either the Faculty Hearing or Faculty Grievance Committees concurrent with appointment as the UMC, and shall not be an active participant or advisor on behalf of any party in any grievance during his or her term(s) as UMC.

B. The <u>UMC University Mediation Coordinator</u> shall operate in accordance with Sections V, VI, VII, and VIII of the Procedures for Resolving Faculty Grievances Arising from Section 607(3) of The Code of The University of North Carolina.
